Retell the stories of the "Three Billy Goats Gruff, The Three Little Pigs and Goldilocks and The Three Bears." Listen to others with increasing attention. Understand use of prepositions e.g. under, on top, behind etc... 	<p>Personal, Social and Emotional Development We are learning to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be confident in asking adults for help. Turn take and share resources. Understand that some actions and words can hurt others' feelings. Make good relationships with other children. 	<p>Mathematics We are learning to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Count to 20 and then beyond. Compare groups of objects using the language "more/less" Recognise numbers to 10 then 20. Use mathematical names for shapes e.g. square, circle. Use positional language e.g. under, over, on top, behind, next to etc... 	<p>Expressive Arts and Design We are learning to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sing familiar songs. Play imaginatively with props and toys. Choose materials to build bridges for the Billy Goats Gruff, houses for the Three Pigs using straws, bricks, lego etc... Mix colours. Print with a variety of objects. 
<p>Physical Development We are learning to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wash and dry our hands independently. Use tools safely e.g. hammers, scissors, plastic knives etc... Move with confidence when climbing and balancing. Hold a pencil between first two fingers and thumb and use it with some control. 	<p>Literacy We are learning to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Form some letters correctly. Draw story maps. Write our names correctly. Hear and say some sounds in words. Recognise some familiar words and signs in books and the environment. 	<p>Understanding the World We are learning to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Talk about our homes and where we live. Learn about Chinese New Year and talk about the differences and similarities in our own celebrations.
