



<p><u>English</u></p> <p>Children will read the story 'The King who banned the dark' and use this as inspiration to create their own story. They will read a range of poetry then create their own poem following conventions. Children will have opportunities to write in different styles (letter and a narrative) and to read non-fiction texts.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Children will secure their knowledge in number and place value. They will explore how to know and use numbers and think how a number is partitioned. The children will solve a range of number and place value problems. They will also practise their addition and subtraction using written methods with numbers that have up to 3 digits.</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>This year the children will be learning to play the ukulele each week. They will begin to learn how to read basic notes and play in time with others in the class. As well as this, the children will study different types of music and songs deciding which they like and dislike. They will learn about pitch, rhythm and clapping in time to the music.</p>
<p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Children will study atlases and maps to improve their knowledge of the countries of The United Kingdom and our place in the world. They will learn the locations of various cities on U.K maps. Children will study Coventry, London, Edinburgh, Cardiff, and Belfast alongside other famous landmarks (physical and human). They will link the national flower and flag to each city.</p>	 	<p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>Children will learn about E-safety and how it is important to think about our self-image and identity when being online. Children will consider how we portray ourselves with our relationships online and how this can impact our reputation. They will have opportunities for word processing some pieces of their work.</p>
<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>The children will be working on improving their invasion skills by playing hockey. They will learn the correct grip, how to pass, receive, travel with the ball, tackle and shoot.</p>	<p><u>Art and Design</u></p> <p>The children will study Lowry and take inspiration from him to paint a City Scape with matchstick people and only using only five colours.</p>	<p><u>Design and Technology</u></p> <p>The children will plan, design, and make a chair or bench. They will be learning about shell structures, 3D nets and CAD designs.</p>
<p><u>MFL</u></p> <p>Children will continue to learn Spanish on a weekly basis. They will learn Spanish phonics and pronunciation this half term.</p>	<p><u>PSHE</u></p> <p>Children will follow the Jigsaw curriculum for PSHE. In this half term they will work on the unit 'Being me in this World'. This will involve themes such as thinking of positive things about themselves and how well they know each other.</p>	<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>Children will learn about many world religions during their time at school. In this half term the children will aim to answer the question: What do different people believe about God?</p>
