

## Frederick Bird Curriculum Overview - Autumn 2021 (2nd half) Year: 1 Theme: Me and my world

<p><u>English</u></p> <p>This half term children will be practising their oracy skills to develop their vocabulary and comprehension. They will use language to recreate roles and experiences to enable them to write with confidence and purpose in a variety of forms. Through story they will be finding out about bees and the natural world.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Children will be learning to add and subtract using the symbols +, - and =. They will develop their knowledge of addition facts and explore number bonds within 10. Children will develop problem solving skills, exploring how many different ways a number can be partitioned.</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Children will be learning what a plant needs to survive. They will learn to identify and name some plants and trees describing their structures. Children will also identify and label parts of the human body associated with the senses and explore how children resemble their parents and the stages of human aging.</p>
<p><u>History</u></p> <p>Children will develop an understanding of chronology and record changes that have occurred in their own lives. They will find out about Queen Elizabeth II and describe things that have changed for her in her lifetime, plotting important dates on a timeline.</p>	<p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Children will investigate their local environment and identify key features where they live on a map of Coventry. They will learn the four points on a compass and identify the four countries of the UK. With the use of maps and atlases they will identify the continents and oceans of the world.</p>	<p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>Using various apps children will learn to record a film using the camera and select images and record a voice over. They will learn to add speech to a video or still image. They will also create videos showing how they have changed from a baby to a child and record their school environment.</p>
<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>Children will develop their gymnastic skills using simple apparatus. They will explore and make decisions about which skills to include in their sequences, to ensure a fluent link between movement. Children will work with a partner and demonstrate taking turns on a mat.</p>	<p><u>Art and Design</u></p> <p>Children will learn what a self portrait is and with inspiration from artists they will explore a variety of media to make their own self-portraits. Children will learn about the artist Thomas Gainsborough and explore different painting styles used by artists.</p>	<p><u>Design and Technology</u></p> <p>Children will learn about seasonal food and find out where food comes from. They will identify and name parts of plants where fruit and vegetables come from. Children will develop safe skills in cutting, peeling, grating and measuring to make a healthy fruit or vegetable kebab.</p>
<p><u>MFL</u></p> <p>MFL is taught in KS2. In KS1 the children respect and celebrate the variety of languages our children are familiar with and explore different ways people may greet each other.</p>	<p><u>PSHE</u></p> <p>Children will follow the Jigsaw Curriculum for PSHE. In this half term the children will work on the unit 'Celebrating Difference'. Children will identify and celebrate differences and similarities between people in their class. They will learn what bullying means and how to get help.</p>	<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>Children will learn about many world religions during their time at school. In this half term the children will find out about the Christian religion. They will learn what objects and places are special to Christians and through stories explore Christians' beliefs about God and Jesus.</p>
