

<p><u>English</u></p> <p>Initially the children will focus on improving the accuracy of their sentence writing. The children will read the story 'Wolves in the Walls' and practise a range of reading and writing skills including writing from the point of view of main characters and creating stories using paragraphs and speech marks.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>On a daily basis, children will revisit previous learning through Magic Maths and Flashback+ tasks. Children will consolidate their knowledge of the measurements for length and will improve their knowledge and recall of multiplication facts. Children will learn written methods for multiplication and division before solving problems.</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>The learning in science will cover the human digestive system and teeth. Children will learn the names of the organs involved in the digestive system and be able to explain what happens to food when it is eaten. Children will learn about the different types of teeth, their role in eating and the reasons why we must look after our own teeth.</p>
<p><u>History</u></p> <p>Children will learn about the experiences of people who lived through slavery at different points of time and in different places around the world. They will recognise the chronology of events in the slave trade and argue the reasons why slavery is abhorrent.</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>Children will continue to follow the Charanga music programme each week. This half term they will begin to learn simple note notation and how to play simple songs on a glockenspiel.</p>	<p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>Children will use the timeline app to present information. Children will understand the threats of cyberbullying and will create e-books using the Book Creator app. The children will also experiment with using green screen technology.</p>
<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>In this half term 4 Robins and 4 Wrens will attend the AT7 Centre to participate in swimming lessons. Children in 4 Owls and 4 Kingfisher classes will learn the basic skills of playing Rugby focussing on evasion skills, throwing, catching, and playing small sided games.</p>	<p><u>Art and Design</u></p> <p>Children in Year 4 will study the collaging style of artwork by Megan Coyle. The children will give their opinions on the artwork before designing and creating their own pieces of collaged work. The children will collect magazine pages and cut them into strips to create different tones and textures.</p>	<p><u>Design and Technology</u></p> <p>Children will develop their knowledge and use of the design process that is used when creating a product. The children will taste different dips, identifying the flavours and experimenting with designing and creating their own product. They will evaluate and improve their product.</p>
<p><u>MFL</u></p> <p>Children will learn to speak Spanish whilst they are in Year 4. The children will learn the phonics required to be able to read Spanish words and then pronounce them accurately. Children will learn phrases and practise speaking confidently.</p>	<p><u>PSHE</u></p> <p>The theme for this half term will be Celebrating Differences. Children will consider what we have in common as people. The children will focus upon what makes one person different and the positive reasons why each individual is different.</p>	<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>In RE this half term the children will be focussing on Christianity looking at why Jesus inspires Christians. They will also discuss the celebration of Christmas.</p>
