- Have moist skin and webbed feet.
- Lay soft eggs.



### Fish

- Cold blooded.
- Live in water.
- Have gills to breathe underwater.
- Lay soft eggs.



### Birds

- Warm blooded.
- Have feathers and a beak.
- Lay hard eggs,



### Mammals

- Warm blooded.
- Have hair or fur.
- Have live babies and feed them milk.



### Insects

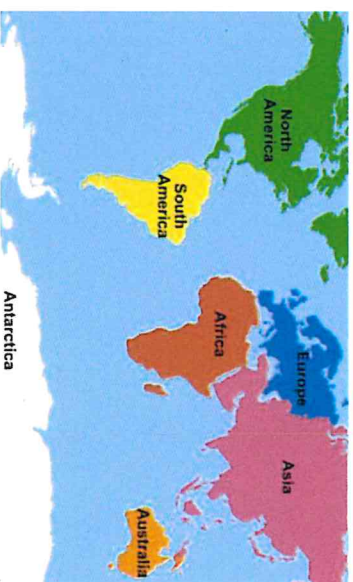
- 3 parts to their body

There are 7 continents.

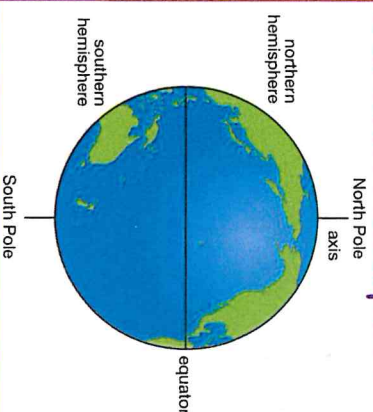


There are 5 oceans.
