Home learning during school closure

Following on from our last update, We are now writing to let you know that we have been instructed to close the school to almost all children after this Friday until further notice.

Your child's learning is very important to us, so we will be continuing to help your child to learn whilst they are at home.

Your child will be given a learning pack which consists of an exercise book, some useful websites and resources to take home today. This will enable you to set some initial tasks for your child during the first week of closure. If your child is not at school for the remainder of the week, a pack can be collected on Monday 23rd March from the school. Collection times are as follows:

10.00 Nursery and Reception

10.30 Year 1 and 2

11.00 Year 3 and 4

11.30 Year 5 and 6

12.00 Parents/carers of children across multiple year groups

Following this, you will be able to access the school's learning platform: Microsoft Teams. A login will be sent home so that children will be able to access and complete work during the school closure. Please regularly check our website for further updates.

It is our expectation that children attempt the work set for them, but also have the opportunity to enjoy the time pursuing their interests where possible.

It is important that you:

- Try and keep some structure to each day
- Read to your children daily and hear your children read
- Get your children outside
- Teach them a new skill
- Create opportunities for children to access practical tasks, e.g. cooking
- Create shared memories with your child, e.g. complete a project together
- Make learning fun and enjoyable and not pressured
- Enjoy the time with your children

We appreciate your continued patience as we deal with this ever-changing situation. We understand that this latest news will have an impact on you and your family and is far from ideal.
